- 2.1 "Written Communications"

  - Mr. Sallee will send a survey to parents about the new reporting format.
- 2.2 "Seismic Mitigation" and the" Seismic Project Advisory Committee"
  - The Long Range Facilities Plan (Feb. 26, 2019) released March 1<sup>st</sup> on the V.S.B. website.
  - Initially it contained some confusing information, which Mr. Sallee rectified with the Board.
  - The Seismic Project Advisory Committee (includes 2 PAC members) has not met yet.
