Encyclopedia, Almanac, and Dictionary Citations

FORMAT:

Author's Last Name, First Name. "Title of Article." *Title of the Resource*. Publisher, Date of Publication.

Examples:

Deitrich, Walter. "Nuclear Energy." The World Book Encyclopedia. World Book, 1995.

"Hockey." The Canadian Encyclopedia. Hurtig, 1988.

"Cloning." Webster's Third New International Dictionary. Merriam-Webster, 1986.

"Endangered Species." *The World Book Almanac and Book of Facts*. World Almanac, 1999, p. 188.

Notes:

- When information in the resource is arranged in alphabetical order, the volume & page number are not required. (See example 1 & 3 above.)
- Volume and page numbers are only required when the resource is not arranged in alphabetical order. (See fourth example 4 above.)
- When there is **no Author**, begin with the title for the article. (See example 2 above.)
