- 1. Updates from Angela
  - i. Teacher librarian started January 5, 2022. Ms. Ngo.
  - ii. Mr. Swain (KD) away until after spring break.
  - iii. New student support worker ½ time to support a student. Also started in January.
  - iv. Angela provided an update on grants from Desjardins. Did not receive the large tech grant but obtained \$500 to use towards the compost bin and tools.
  - v. Donation from West Coast seeds for the garden. Enough for this year and next.
  - vi. Report cards out January 31st. If any questions or concerns, start w the teacher.
  - vii. KD applications due January 31<sup>st</sup> to enter draw or have priority. Otherwise on waist list.

  - ix. COVID UPDATE
    - BCCDC guidelines are what are to be followed. May conflict with DBH guidelines or statements. Numerous changes to self-isolation guidelines in the past few days. Currently in flux as many changes. Current rules for kids under 18 who test positive is to stay home for min 5 days (from 10) or until no longer sick. Unvaccinated adults who test positive must stay home for 10 days. Information is changing constantly.

### x. Functional closure discussion:

 Only in the event there are not enough staff available to keep the kids safe. Could be that administration or other people could be deployed to the schools from other schools or from the district management team. The goal is to not close schools.
