## **MyEducationBC Accounts**

Reminder that MyEducationBC is the student information system for the Vancouver School Board. A Student/Family Portal Account has been created by the district for all students at University Hill Secondary School. This account is a shared account where students and parents can access student schedules, daily/class attendance, course grades and report cards. It is imperative that you share the account information (password) as a family (with your child). Your login for this account is your child's student number.

## <u>Absences</u>

Parents/guardians reminder you should now be reporting absences to the office by email at <a href="mailto:uhillswitchboard@vsb.bc.ca">uhillswitchboard@vsb.bc.ca</a>
Emails should be sent using a parent/guardian email address and should provide the <a href="mailto:students">students</a> name, date of absence, grade, <a href="mailto:students">student</a> students must be reminded that falsifying attendance notes is unacceptable. It is the student's responsibility to make up any work that is missed, regardless of the reason for the absence. Exceptions to this may be granted due to unforeseen circumstances. If a student becomes ill while at school, or has an appointment during school time, student's must sign out at the office. Students will only be released with parent permission. Students who are ill should not come to school and if they attend school and is deemed to be unwell, parents/guardians will be contacted to pick up their child.

Hello University Hill Secondary Students! It's Mark, your friendly Safe and Caring Schools support worker. The <a href="mailto:erase|Report It">erase|Report It</a> tool lets you send a secure, anonymous and confidential message about concerns you're having to your school or school district's safe school coordinator, who will follow up on it right away. You do not have to provide your name unless you want to.
