INFORMATION ITEMS (ADVOCACY & COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT)

- Approve Minutes from last meeting- approved
- Mrs. Wallace Grade 7 year-end celebration: a day in Trout Lake park with challenge games, individual food brought in, etc. Unfortunately due to COVID, Grade 7's havent been able to fundraise this year. They have been able to buy hoodies but not much left over after. Ms Wallace asking \$300-\$500 for enough money to buy food for kids (White Spot) and possibly a colour photo for kids to blow up and get signatures on. They are still awaiting the money for the cans and bottles which will come form PAC in addition to her ask. Christopher S will donate \$100 and will set that up. Ali will contact White Spot to see if they can donate food for the event. There are 33 Grade 7s in total (\$20/each would be about \$660). PAC to give \$1000 +\$179 and Julia to ask Ms W. if that is enough or if additional funds required. Note: Most kids are going to Gladstone with 4 to Windemere; 7 kids to Van Tec, 2 going elsewhere. Metals have been purchased already. Ms W to talk with Lani re: Bottle/Can sharing the recycling code for Grade 7s in a newsletter to the rest of the school.

Beaconsfield Garden Update

Significant interest in school garden by staff and students this year. Soil and tools were delivered today. Divisions 3 and 4 put the soil in the garden. Ms. Billingsley and Ms. Ward are teacher leaders for the garden this year.

• School Fees - Update for 2021-2022

\$35 – supplies

\$7 – agendas (Grades 1-7 only)

- Fee increase of \$2 per agenda, cost hasn't increased for years and years
- School was not able to cover cost of agendas this year with 2020-2021 fee collection.
- No performance fees are being collected for 2021-2022.

• <u>Learning Conferences</u>

Teachers will be reaching out to parents/guardians about the 'shape' of these conferences for this Spring. Early dismissal is 2 pm on April 29^{th} .

• <u>Virtual Scholastic Book Fair</u>

Ms. Quinlan, our teacher librarian, has kindly offered to host a VIRTUAL book fair this year. Stay tuned. It will be in May 2021.

BUDGET Report – Julia see Budget

• Garden -Teachers have been really working hard in the garden this year. Kathy spoke about request from teachers for money to purchase plastic fences to divide up garden plots. Kathy and her husband looked at fence around garden and suggests 36 more cedar pickets (and screws) and received a quotation from Standard Building Supplies for \$106 incl tax. Kathy and her husband will do the work. Bilyana offered to paint once the fence is up. Note: Lani checked with VSB and fixing the fence is a parent responsibility. \$175 has been spent by school for gloves, etc. \$140 paid for barrels and shovels. Soil is \$210. \$325 for seeds etc. (at \$25 for each class). \$50 for painting by Bilyana. Remainder is cost for structural repairs as fence is unsafe as it stands at the moment. Rose put forth motion for PAC to put \$1000 towards garden at Beaconsfield. Motion second. Lani to ask Tracey to send invoice to Julia.

Communications Update - Bilyana (Bilyana not in attendance tonight)

Future Parent Workshop Update in our new outdoor classroom – Ali (10 - 15 min)

 Parent Interest Survey via Lani -continued COVID restrictions on gatherings so nothing moved forward on this for now. For follow up in September.

End of Pandemic Year Celebration —Suggestion for something for teachers; a Staff Appreciation lunch with sandwiches from La Grotta Del Formaggio and chips and drinks. For 50-55 staff (\$9 per sandwich +drinks and chips and packaged desserts for \$12 total per staff member=\$600). Note: roughly \$600 approved for last year. Carlene will set up list of sandwich choices for Lani and will organize lunch for mid-June.

• Lani talked to teachers about year-end celebration and suggestion for dividing up money for each division to spend on: outdoor water fun, prepackaged food, give teachers autonomy to decide what to do with money. Ask would be 13 divisions at Beaconsfield (\$200 each for div 1-4; div 5-12 would be \$150 each) =\$2150 from PAC. Julia put forth motion for **PAC to give \$2150 divided** among divisions for 'Class Celebrations.' Rose second the motion.

Rose asked if we'd be interested in continuing Zoom for post pandemic meetings. Suggestions for combination face-to-face and Zoom for future meetings once restrictions lifted.

PAC Executive Positions for 2021-2022 -Julia wants to give up Treasurer. Rose will step in to replace Julia but will not be Chair then.

Lani would like to discuss STEM at Beaconsfield. Lani requesedt for this to be added to May Agenda.
