Hello Britannia Families,

Further to the <u>letter that was sent out today by the Superintendent of Schools</u>, we wanted provide you with some additional information about what is happening during the week of March 30 to April 3 with the cancellation of classes.

As mentioned in the superintendent's letter, health and safety of everyone in our community is our first priority. With that in mind, we will be working with Britannia staff next week to determine a plan to connect with students and families, likely on Thursday or Friday. Our goal is to provide learning opportunities for our students, but these won't be available until at least the week of April 5. More information about this will be sent to you next week through our school messaging system which has sent this notice.

To support our students who are registered in our LunchSmart lunch program while classes are cancelled, we will be distributing bag lunches from the outside of the cafeteria on the west side of the school on starting Monday, March 30 from 11:30 am to 1:00 pm. Students are asked to go to the outside of the cafeteria by walking along the north side of the gym, by the tennis courts. All students are asked to 'social distance' from each other by remaining 2 metres apart at all times. Marks will be put onto the ground to indicate 2 metre distances and signs will be placed along the walls where students may be lining up. Students will be asked to pick up a lunch and then leave the area by walking along the track by the field to the parking lot.

We want to thank all of you for your patience and understanding as we work to provide services to our students and families. We will get through this together.
