1. PHO Order and Schools

Following the <u>latest order and direction of the Provincial Health Officer (PHO)</u>, Dr. Bonnie Henry, on province-wide restrictions, we wanted to highlight these points which are of particular relevance to the school. Please discuss these with you child(ren):

- All individuals, places of work and businesses are directed to significantly reduce social interactions and travel.
- There are no social gatherings of any size with anyone outside of your immediate household.
 There is an exception for those living alone who have the option of a core bubble of two people who live outside of their immediate household.
- With respect to the order around socializing, we are asking all staff and students to minimize
 casual hallway gatherings. These can reduce the width of the hallway, impeding physical distancing
 for those wanting to pass, and most importantly, have the potential to breach the spirit of the
 PHO order to not socialize with others outside of your households. Students should enter and
 leave the school by the entrance nearest their classroom and should only travel directly to and
 from their classroom.
- School fitness and physical education classes are not included in this order and can continue with current safety protocols.
- Schools are not considered public spaces and are therefore not included in the revised mask orders. Currently, students are required to wear masks while in the halls and when it is not possible to physically distance. However, we have increased signage in the school around masks and are encouraging students to wear masks in all spaces. Our Student Council has developed signage in addition to ones provided to the school by the district.

- 3-ply masks are now recommended by Health Canada and this recommendation is expected to be
 adopted in BC. As such, the VSB is in the process of ordering more cloth non-medical masks for
 staff and students. These will be 2-ply with a pocket. The 3rd ply will be the responsibility of the
 wearer (staff or student). This will permit the wearer to add a basic or more advanced 3rd layer.
 We don't yet know when these will arrive for distribution.
- If students are eating their lunch at school, they are asked to maintain a 2m distance.
- A reminder of the <u>student daily health assessment</u>. Continue to monitor your child(ren) daily and to keep them home if they have symptoms.

2. VSB Parent Survey

The following email was sent today to all Britannia parents and guardians: Hello families of Vancouver secondary school students!

As we look toward the end of the second quarter, we are beginning to plan for the next two quarters, the upcoming course selection for students and the next school year. We know these days are trying for many and there are demands for everyone's time and attention. However, we ask that you provide us with some information on topics important for us to know about as we make those plans. Students will be asked to consider the same topics by staff at their schools.
