- 4. BUDGET Report Julia (3 min) Accounts reviewed. See report.
- 5. PAC Welcome Table (Ali 5 min) PAC info table held out front/beside school in the morning first week of October. Suggestion to set up near kindergarten doors next time to be able to talk to new parents. Surveys ready to go -Suggestion to have Zoom link on survey so parents can attend and a link to PAC Facebook page. Suggestion to add a few brief details about PAC as well, particularly what PAC is (and that parents can attend and just listen to PAC meetings and not sign up for anything).

- 6. Garden Update (Kathy 5 min) garden beds look amazing. If anyone wants to do some weeding, please feel free to weed around apple trees, but refrain from weeding garden beds as these are being gardened by classes. **Bilyana** was approved for some PAC funds during the last meeting to paint the fence around the garden. She will come back to PAC with some design ideas. **Shelley's** husband can assist with painting supplies at a good price.
- 7. PAC Mailbox (Kathy 5 min) There was <u>a lot</u> of mail from the PAC mailbox (from April until now!) Greeting card idea added to fundraiser ideas (below), pamphlet regarding suggestion for Gladstone's name to be changed to Rosemary Brown High School, lots of fundraiser flyers, etc.
- 8. Ukulele Program Claire Baker (10 min) Lani to speak to this item on Claire Baker's behalf. Ms Baker has spoken to some teachers about possibility of classes learning/ playing ukelele Quotes from Play Music and Long & Macquade:

PLAY MUSIC:

*30 Beaver Creek Concert Ukelele for Grades 5-7 is \$52.30 each = \$1569.00 (With Bag)

*25 Kala Ukadelic Soprano for Grade 1-3 is \$34.80 each = \$870.00 (With Bag)

LONG & MACQUADE:

*25 Duke Denver Soprano Sparkle ukeleles at 37.50 each = \$937.50 (4 colours and comes with bag)
*30 Duke Denver Soprano Ukeleles 30 at 40.99 each = \$1,229.70 (10 colours and comes with bag)

Question: does PAC have interest in supporting ukeleles? Does PAC need a proposal? Discussion last year was that if teachers want to do a music program, to create a proposal and present it to PAC. Recorders purchased (100) last year not usable right now due to COVID (due to blowing into the recorder). **Lani** will look to VSB for clarification if kids/teachers can sing (while playing Ukeleles during COVID.

Fundraising Opportunities (Rose – 15 min)

- a. Purdy's Chocolate Fundraiser & Cookie Dough- Xmas/Easter
 —flyers will have to go out first week of November. Due November 28th. April will assist, but not spearhead. It will be paperless this year, so plan to advertise online. PAC decided not to do Purdy's fundraiser this year.

- b. Special Pink Shirt Fundraiser

- c. Shopfunds Fundraiser for Xmas might be a good fundraiser with COVID this year. This year, a link would go out and then someone would just need to collate the cards. Julia, Aaron, April, Rose will work on Shopfunds this year. Julia will contact them and would like to start passing on 'Shopfunds' on to someone else: Shelley and Rose will take over. Bilyana will create a newsletter about it. Lani will look into rules and regs for advertising (and limits) with parent emails and respond back to Rose
