## Talking with Youth About Cannabis: A Workshop for Parents and Caregivers

Are you wondering how to talk to your teens about cannabis use? This workshop gives parents, guardians, or caregivers the tools to have effective conversations about cannabis to help support the youth in their lives. Research suggests that lecturing and using scare tactics is less effective at preventing youth from using substances and can increase stigma surrounding these subjects. Instead, this workshop provides participants with ideas on how to frame more open, youth-friendly, and honest conversations with a focus on positive youth development.
