Rupert and Renfrew Station Area Plan

The City of Vancouver would like your input as we create a plan for the area around the Rupert and Renfrew SkyTrain stations (see map below).

Building on the draft Vancouver Plan, the Renfrew Rupert Station Area Plan will guide growth and change. The area plan will help to:

- Advance reconciliation
- Add new housing options close to transit
- Protect Still Creek and manage flood risk
- Support job growth, and
- Make it easier to walk or roll through the area.

Additional opportunities will be identified in collaboration with the x^wməθk^wəyəm (Musqueam), Skwxwú7mesh (Squamish), and səlilwətał (Tsleil-Waututh) Nations, as well as residents, local businesses and community organizations.

If you and/or your group already participated in the Vancouver Plan, we would like to thank you for your time and contribution. We are reaching out now, to see if you would like to be involved in the Rupert and Renfrew Station Area planning process.

We have a few ways to get involved now:

- Complete the online survey (closes May 31)
- Map your neighbourhood online (closes May 31)
- Attend an in-person open house (May 18 or 24)
- Attend an online mapping workshop (May 19 or 28)
- Sign-up on our mailing list to hear about future open houses
