1. <u>Remembrance Day at Britannia</u>

Britannia will hold virtual Remembrance Day assemblies on Tuesday, November 10 in the morning and afternoon classes. Students will be given poppies at the start of each class and will have the option of making a donation to the Vancouver Poppy Fund. We would like to stress that the donation is optional. Britannia families may also able to able to donate to the poppy fund through <u>School Cash Online</u>, the system used by the school to collect school fees. Once again, please note this is completely voluntary.

2. <u>Preparing for Quarter 2 Classes</u>

Quarter 2 is starting on Nov 18. Teachers will be contacting students letting them know if they will be in the A (morning) or B (afternoon) sections of their Q2 courses starting next week. If students haven't heard from their teachers by Thursday, November 12th, they should contact their counsellor who can help them to understand their Q2 schedule. Students and families can also see this information on the Portal. The A or B sessions for Q2 will be updated and visible on the portal as of Tuesday, November 10th. We will be printing and reviewing timetables with all the grade 8 students on Friday, November 13th. Each grade 8 student will spend a few minutes with a counsellor or transition teacher to ensure they understand their schedule for Quarter 2.

Photo Retake Day is on November 13th. Retakes will be available for students in both the morning and the afternoon.

4. <u>Public Health/VCH COVID 19 Positive Case Notification Process</u>

The Vancouver School District (VSB), in consultation with Vancouver Coastal Heath (VCH), have created <u>this flow chart</u> of how the VCH notification process unfolds when a member of a school community is tested for COVID-19. It is for your information.
