MyEd BC Portal

All MyEd BC Student Family accounts will be suspended by July 31, then re-open for a short time from Aug.15-Aug.19 for summer school report cards viewing. There will be no access to the published report card after July 31 except summer school students will have temporary access from Aug.15-19. Should you foresee the need to access your published report card during the summer, we suggest that you print a hardcopy or save a digital copy to a medium that you will be able to access. You can request copy of your report card from your school's main office during summer hours (8 am to 3 pm). Returning students' accounts will be reactivated on the first day of school and will be accessible by their last successful login ID and password.
