A BOOK WITH AN AUTHOR

Information for the citation should be taken directly from the book's title page and the verso of the title page. Do not rely solely on the book cover.

FORMAT:

Author's Last Name, Author's First Name. *Book Title*. Publisher, Date of Publication.

Examples:

Lennon, Paul. The Keyboard Player's Chord Bible. Chartwell Books, 2008.

Trager, James. The Food Chronology. University Press, 1995.

Wilson, Ryder. *The Book of House and Garden Plants for West Coast Climates*. Hyperion Press, 2010.

Note:

• In the last example above, the information does not fit on one line; therefore, the 2nd line of the entry must be indented a minimum of 5 spaces or characters.

This is called a "Hanging Indent".
