Free tuition

- September to June (3 days/ week for 10 months)
- VCC Downtown Campus
- Partnership between the Vancouver School District and VCC
- Program covers: introduction to hairstyling; hygiene, bacteriology and sanitation; client relations; hair cutting/styling; communications and salon functions; scalp and hair treatments and hair colouring.

Requirements

Courses: English 10

Characteristics: Sincere interest in administering personal services, interpersonal and communication skills required for providing customer service, ability to plan and work independently, self-motivated and sense of responsibility, basic writing and numerical kills, interest in art, fashion, creativity or design.
