Student Belongings and Learning Materials Pick-up

- Today we have finished three days of students retrieving materials from their lockers.
- Next Tuesday and Thursday between 11:30 pm and 1:00 pm students can come to the school, **if they have been contacted by their teachers**, to pick up materials for learning at home.

• Distribution of materials will be done at the doors leading to the GYM.

- Students who would like to retrieve materials from their lockers may also come at this time (Tuesday and Thursday between 11:30 and 1:00).
 - **Students must report to the doors leading to the Gym** where they will be escorted to their lockers.
 - Only students (not adults) will be permitted in the school.

Health and Safety

- Ensuring health and safety is our top priority as we all work to support our students.
- Should you have any pressing concerns or needs including food and groceries, please do not hesitate to contact your child's grade counsellor or program teacher.

Continuity of Learning

- Goals: The continuation of learning and assessment during the COVID-19 response will recognize and reflect the following learning goals:
 - Learning Together: A partnership between families and educators
 - Learning in a New Space: A journey with many pathways of curiosity and exploration
 - Learning for All: An opportunity for engagement and connections for all students
- Continuity of Learning Tips for Parents
 - The district has posted a new page on its website containing <u>Tips for Parents</u> for supporting your grade 8 to 12 teen. The site has many useful strategies and considerations for you during the COVID-19 pandemic and you are encouraged to have a look.

- Assessment and Reporting of Continuity of Learning
 - The district is creating a document for families to explain the guidelines for the assessment and reporting of the learning that will take place during the COVID-19 pandemic. This is not yet available, but we expect to be able to share it with you soon.
 - Some of the key understandings of the district guidelines are:
 - Each student will receive a report card in June with a final grade in each of their courses.
 - Final grades will take into consideration assessment of learning prior to spring break and evidence of learning in relation to essential learning standards during the learning at home period.
 - Every student eligible to graduate from Grade 12 this year will graduate.
 - Schools will continue to support individual students who were not achieving a passing grade as of March 13.
