#### 1. Report Cards

The quarter system brings with it changes to report cards. Students will receive a mid-quarter mark half-way through each quarter, and a final grade at the end of each quarter. So they will receive eight report cards (two reports per quarter), but only two subjects per report card. Some students are taking courses all year long (Skills, ELL, Hockey). These courses will be reported on once in January and again in June. Grade 8 students will receive proficiency scales: Extending, Applying, Developing, Beginning. Grade 9 students will receive letter grades. Grade 10-12 students will receive a % and a letter grade.

## 2. Grad Photos

## 3. School Fees

<u>The Britannia School Fee Schedule for 2020-2021</u> has been revised due to the reduced number of times that classes are meeting this year.

Student Activities/ Student Leadership Fees remain unchanged although this fee will include the cost of providing a student agenda to each student.

Fees for lockers will not be charged as lockers will not be used this year.

Fees will not be charged for IB and Venture banquets and camps as these activities may not be occurring this year.

Grad Fees may be charged depending on the activities that will be permitted. This will be determined in the spring of 2021.

Many supplemental course fees have been reduced or eliminated. Some remain unchanged.

Deposit fees for workbooks and musical instruments remain unchanged.

The Board of Education Trustees is committed to ensuring that no school-age student will be denied an opportunity to participate in a course, class or program because of an inability to pay fees. ## 4. Homework Club is Open

Homework Club has RE OPENED with new Health and Safety Guidelines:

- Only 15 students allowed in room 221
- AND 15 students allowed in room 222
- Students come to the room and are seated at a social distance according to the arrangement of the desks of the room. Chairs and tables may NOT be moved.
- Sign in is remote via Ms Wai and Ms Simonson. Do NOT line up and sign up as usual.
- Everyone must wear a mask.
- Everyone is encouraged to wash hands or use hand sanitizer.
- You may borrow a laptop. We now have 6 new Macbook Airs, but they must stay in the rooms, and they must be sanitised after use.
- We have a new printer which prints out from our laptops, so assignments can be printed out.
- Tutoring is ONLINE only via zoom. No outside people may come to our rooms. We have tutors for Math, Science, English and Socials Studies.
- NO food is currently allowed to be served but you may bring your own food. Students who stay an hour or more will receive a \$5 gift card to Tim Hortons.( this is a temporary situation).

## 5. Britannia Lunch Program

For students who have registered for the Britannia Lunch Program, daily lunches and weekly lunch kits can be picked up from INSIDE the cafeteria between 10.30 am and 1.15 pm.
