FORMAT:

Last Name of 1st Author, First Name of Author and the 2nd Author's

First Name and Last Name. Title of the book. Publisher, Date of

Publication.

Examples:

Adams, Norman and Joe Singer. Drawing Jungle Animals. Watson-Guptill,

1979.

Baines, Jacob and John Malek. Atlas of Ancient Egypt. Facts on File, 1982.

Note:

- The title of the book is in *italics*.
- The names of the two authors are divided by the word "and".
- The order of the names is different for each author.
- When information does not fit on one line, remember to indent the 2nd line of the entry, a minimum of 5 spaces / characters.
