Special Note for 2020-2021 Season:

The BC School Sport "Return to Sport Plan" is one of the important resources in our Killarney planning. It is, however, important to note the VSB has additional requirements and restrictions beyond those of BCSS: related to school facilities use, spectators and use of outside (non-VSB staff) coaches or sponsors.

Currently, no outside coaches or spectators are permitted in our planning. All of our Killarney Athletics activity will involve monitoring of safe social distancing, hand cleaning before and after all activity, cleaning of equipment at the start of all activity, cleaning of used spaces between activities, and staff/student wearing of masks before and after sporting activity.

While inter-school competition is currently not permitted in-person, there may be a possibility of virtual competitions in sports such as cross country running.

All other athletic activity (except regular PE classes) at Killarney will likely be of a training and practice nature, conducted entirely within the school student cohort. Any intra-school competition would have to be in a sport that is easily socially distanced during the game.

Sports that will be offered will be determined based on the student sign up and the availability of staff volunteering as coaches (at this point with Stage 2 our valued Community Coaches unfortunately cannot be involved).
