At the public meeting of the Board of Education held on October 26, 2020 the Board passed the following motion:

That the City be informed of our support.
The šx ${ }^{w} w ə \dot{q}^{w}$ ə ${ }^{2}$ ət Crosstown community have been advocating extensively for traffic safety measures to be put in place to protect students arriving and departing from school. With a school near such a busy corridor, the request for a school zone to be put in place on Expo Boulevard aligns well with the recommendations that the Council passed after receiving the 2020 Transportation Safety Update in July 2020.

For families who drive, having a designated parking lot during drop off and pick-up will further improve transportation safety for the community. As such, the PAC has determined that the parking lot on the south side of Expo Boulevard between Carrall Street and Abbott Street is the best location.
