#### 1. Report Cards

The October report card with the mid-quarter marks for students' 1.1 and 1.4 classes will be posted to the Portal on Friday, October 16th before 4pm. Instructions to access the Portal are listed are found <a href="https://example.com/here">here</a>. Please note that there will be no comment for full-year classes (Skills, Hockey, ELL) at this time. Teachers of full-year classes will provide a comment and work habit on the November report card, alongside the final quarter marks for 1.1 and 1.4 classes.

Report cards will be located on the <u>MyEd family portal</u>. Please follow the instructions below to help you find your child's report card:

- 1. Type in your child's student number for the login
- 2. Your password is the one that you and your child have already been using. If you have not yet logged in, please visit our website <a href="here">here</a>
- 3. You will find your child's report card under "Published Reports" on the right-hand side.
- 4. <u>Please note report cards are deleted after each report</u>. You may wish to save a copy for your records

# What if I forgot my password?

- 1. Click on the "I forgot my password" link.
- 2. A response should come to the email that is associated with the account.
- 3. If you do not recall the email associated with the account please phone Britannia's school office during business hours (8:30 3:30 pm) at 604-713-8266 to ask for support in resetting your password. Office staff can also help you look up the email associated with your Family Portal account.
