- 3. BUDGET Report Julia (3 min) Report reviewed by attendees.
- 4. Communications Update Bilyana (3 min) Colour scheme on email changed. Bilyana plan to see what the news used to look like and mock something new up. She will bring it to PAC when she has drafted up something exciting.
- 5. Follow up Parent Survey Ali (5 min) 32 respondents, 'Arts and Music' opportunities and 'School Garden' noted as priority interest areas for parents to support PAC with, 'Mental Health' and 'Inclusion' info sessions popular choice, 'not sure/need more' info about a class representative for PAC. **Lani** to send out info re: Parents PAC FB site.
- 6. Follow Up Fundraising Opportunities (Rose 15 min)
 - a. Special Pink Shirt Fundraising (Spirit Wear
 - i. Teacher support, no call for Art but will promote pink shirt day, collect forms, etc.); Beaconsfield logo the preferred choice.
 - Suggestion for having a logo on the back like a rainbow for 'after COVID the sun shines'.
 - Suggestion for Bilyana (and Melissa offered to help as well) will make 1 page electronic template and send around to PAC list for preview of ideas first, then send a link electronically for kids to create art and submit for pink shirts. Lani can give paper copies to families as needed as well and to have announcement made at school so kids also know. Are rules for what kids should submit required? (e.g. block colours, no shading -April will send Bilyana ideas for 'rules' for submitting art) Slight increase in charge (+/-\$1) for multicoloured shirt compared to B&W. Suggestion for 'call for ideas/what would you like to see on the shirt' and general themes or ideas like 'acceptance,' 'kindness' and 'community' as opposed to 'if you win, your idea will be on the shirt' so that a few ideas can be combined.
 - ii. Pink shirt day is Feb 24, 2021: Orders must be in by Feb 5, 2021.
 - iii. Can reuse Canuck Volleyball again they cannot have a website link for ordering for us. They want the order, we'll pay for it, they give us shirts, we do the donation part on our own.
 - iv. Charge at cost, be inclusive? If there's a concurrent donation campaign for 'pink shirt day,' it can't be advertised as 'donation for a shirt,' anti-bullying is not part of school curriculum, activities are part of non-instructional time and this is part of community building.
 - v. Ideas for Donation/cause to put money towards?? **Table for next meeting** (suggestion for donation towards 'buddy bench')
