 Motion to approve January 18, 2022 minutes by Julia Ko, seconded by Rose Ngo.
- 2. PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE Mr. Joel Levine
 - Changes in health and safety, for school gathering and events for just the school's population, there is no occupancy limit. Caveat to go slow and go with the comfort level of staff and families.
 - 50 people maximum or 50 percent of capacity for Non-School Population
 - No proof of vaccination required for events
 - Visitors are permitted on school grounds for student health and well-being.
 - Rapid Test are coming
 - Mindfulness Monday and gift cards were a successful initiative.
 - School Fees for next year \$35 for supplies, \$6 Agendas Gr. 1 7, no other fees. Fees can be waived for hardships. Parents can notify Mr. Levine.
 - February 23, 2022 Pink Shirt Day.
 - Questions about Absentees: When school first started in January 20 -40 children were absent a day, now little absenteeism.
 - Wellness Project proposed by Teachers so far similar to a Terry Fox run

 - b. N95 masks \$192.57 to Kathy GENERAL ACCT chq0001 + \$192.57 chq 0002 to Julia K GENERAL ACCT
 - c. gift cards for staff draws \$200 to Kathy T. chq0001 GENERAL ACCT
 - i. four gift cards have been drawn so far... kathy can purchase four more to top up the choices for March
 - ii. Winners have been: Cam, Paul Myers, Cheryl Jo, and Angela Ward.

- 5. READING KITS to improve literacy skills. the school has purchased several of them for different levels over the years but are missing one set that would benefit our youngest readers. They are very expensive, the kit (with over 100 books) costs \$3895. Would the PAC be interested in supporting?

 - c. difficulties with the mess in the past... keep it outside? maybe after school? maybe pre-order and delivery like the veggie program in the yellow bins to classes
 - d. Maybe it's a PAC funded treat handed out at the end of the year or special occasion to each student?
