- 3. Principal's Message Mr. Joel Levine
 - Kids settled into classes Friday afternoon
 - Some intermediate grades are small may have other kids come from around district as needed
 - Racism training as first day
 - 214 kids in Beaconsfield;
 - Supervisor positions open & support staff members leaving; teaching staff is stable
 - COVID protocol: similar to Jun 2021 protocol; kids are used to it; online activities for the time being; or class by class activities;
 - School plan: focused on writing for academics; Joel to send a survey to staff to find out their thoughts
 - Beaconsfield has a reputation as a very nice school
 - Discretionary spending per class (typically \$100 per class) will this persist
 - COVID reporting: Joel follows the Vancouver Coastal Health guidelines
 - Lost and found can it be reinstated (Ali question)
 - After school programs are allowed by VCH Joel to connect with Scott Dyel
