Social Studies (Asian Heritage Month)

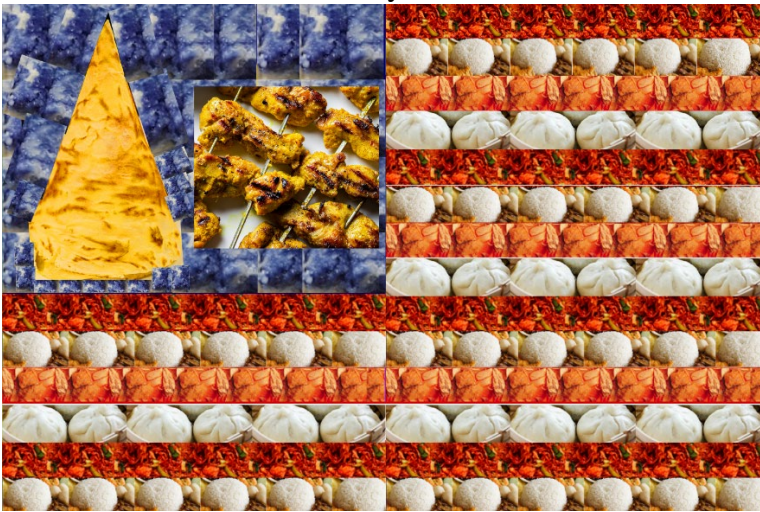
Grade 9 and 10
