Flashcards For Presentations/Speeches

Why use flashcards?

not reading word for word

easier to interact with the audience

presentation sounds more natural

easy to make eye contact

important points stand out move around the room freely can include cues, props and transitions

easy to practice the presentation

TIPS FOR WRITING FLASHCARDS

- Use only ONE card for each topic
- Write on ONE side only
- Write using a large font so it's easy to read
- Leave white space so important points stand out
- Write the topic on the top left corner
- Use colour to identify different important info
- Write the main heading in one colour
- Put details under the main heading in another colour
- Use bullet points instead of sentences
- Include prop cues (e.g. Show slide 1 of PowerPoint)
- Include cues to show when to move to the next topic
- Mark approximate timing on the cards

TIPS FOR ORGANIZING

- Number each card on the bottom right corner
- Put a hole on the top left corner
- Keep the cards together with a ring or string
