Semester 1 Report Cards

Semester 1 Final Reporting

Final reports for semester 1 will be posted to MyEducation BC on February 9, 2021, by 1:00 pm.

- Student progress is reported using cumulative assessment, which means that the grade a student receives always reflects the student's most recent and updated progress.
- Report cards will include a final course mark, work habit and comment. Grade 10 to 12 courses will report student progress using percentages. Grade 8 & 9 student progress will be reported using a Proficiency Scale.
- Students enrolled in Full-Year Courses that run September to June will be receiving a mid-point mark based on their progress to date on February 1.

How to access your student's report card on the MyEducation BC Family Portal

- Final reports will be found on the MyEducation BC Family Portal. Please follow the instructions below to locate your child's report:
 - Go to the MyEd Website (https://www.myeducation.gov.bc.ca/aspen/logon.do)
 - Type in the student number as the login ID; the password is the one you have been using
 - You will find the report card under "Published Reports" on the right-hand side.
 - Please note reports are deleted when new reports are generated. You may wish to save a copy

- A response should come to the email that is associated with the account.
