A BOOK WITH MORE THAN TWO AUTHORS

Information for the citation should be taken directly from the book's title page and the verso of the title page. Do not rely solely on the book cover.

FORMAT:

Last Name of 1st author, First Name et al. *Title of the Book*.

Publisher, Date of Publication.

Examples:

Allaby, Michael et al. The Illustrated Dictionary of Science. Facts on File,

1995.

Eisl, Markus et al. Water: Exploring the Blue Planet. Firefly Books, 2010.

Note:

- Begin with the name of the first author mentioned.
- The abbreviation "et al." replaces the names of the other authors.
- When the information for the resource does not fit on one line, the 2nd line is always indented a minimum of 5 spaces / characters. This is called the "Hanging Indent".

Always remember to review the General Rules that appear on the "Citing Resources – MLA style" page.
