WHAT IS DISCOVERY TOY BASKET?

**Discovery Toy Basket** is an experience inspired by the idea of **Heuristic Play**, a term coined by child psychologist, Elinor Goldschmeid in the 1980's (*Let's Play!* 2019).

Heuristic Play describes the activity of babies and children as they play with and



explore the properties of 'objects' in the real world (Little Acorns to Mighty Oaks 2013)

This child-led activity allows endless opportunities for exploration, creativity, and invention while children learn the fundamentals of science. By asking openended questions, you are also able to support the development of children's communication and literacy skills (*Let's Play!* 2019).

# **ACTIVITY**

- Place a variety of objects into a basket, tub, or small cardboard box (e.g. keys, kitchen utensils and recycled household items).
- Present it to the child without directing their play.
- Ask open ended questions, such as
   Can you tell me what is inside?
   Does it make any noise?
   What do you think you can do with it?
- Remember, there are no right or wrong answers!





### **OUTSIDE EXTENSION**

Take it outside and add some natural elements, such as pinecones, leaves, flowers, stones, seashells, and twigs!
