Nootka Fine Arts Program

- The Nootka Fine Arts Program (K-7) is a VSB choice program
- Focus on the 4 Fine Arts Domains:
 - Visual Arts
 - Dance
 - Drama
 - Music
- Approximately 30% of curriculum dedicated to the four Fine Arts domains. (Classic = 20%)
- Emphasis on skill development through the arts (collaboration, problem solving and communication)
- Gr 4-7 electives

- 1. Register at your catchment school
- 2. Apply online for your choice program between January 11 and February 3, 2021 (at 4:00 PM) (https://kchoice.vsb.bc.ca)
- 3. Spots awarded by lottery draw at the district.
- 4. You will be contacted before the end of February.
- 5. If a spot is offered, you have 24 hours to accept

Priority:

- 1. Siblings (but still must register online before deadline)
- 2. Nootka Fine Arts as first choice

- 1. Grade 1-7 Fine Arts applications accepted between **November 2020** and January 31, 2021

- 2. Applicants will be placed on a waitlist.
- 3. Placements will begin to be determined after spring break
- 4. Spots awarded by lottery draw.
- 5. You will be contacted only if a spot becomes available.
- 6. If a spot is offered, you have 24 hours to accept
- 7. Remaining names will be placed on a waitlist (and kept until June 30, 2022)
