## **BOOK WITH EDITOR(S) OR NO AUTHOR**

Information for the citation should be taken directly from the book's title page and the verso of the title page. Do not rely solely on the book cover.

## **FORMAT:**

Title of the Book. Publisher, Date of Publication.

## **Examples:**

The Art of the Italian Renaissance: architecture, sculpture, painting, drawing. Konemann, 1995.

The Penguin Book of First World War Prose. Viking Press, 1989.

## Note:

- No Author? Or Editor(s)? Begin with the *Title of the Resource*.
- When you put this type of entry in alphabetical order, arrange it by the keyword, not the article "the".
- When the information for a resource does not fit on one line, the 2<sup>nd</sup> line is indented a minimum of 5 spaces / characters. (See example 1 above.)
