# SCHOOL/OFFICE REMINDERS

#### **MyEducationBC Accounts**

Reminder that MyEducationBC is the student information system for the Vancouver School Board. A Student/Family Portal Account has been created by the district for all students at University Hill Secondary School. This account is a shared account where students and parents can access student schedules, daily/class attendance, course grades and report cards. It is imperative that you share the account information (password) as a family (with your child). Your login for this account is your child's student number.

# **Absences**

Parents/guardians reminder you should now be reporting absences to the office by email at <u>uhillswitchboard@vsb.bc.ca</u> Emails should be sent using a parent/guardian email address and should provide the **students name**, **date of absence**, **grade**, **student number and reason for the absence**. <u>For extended absences</u> parents/guardians must email the student's counsellor. A student should also be provided a note for their teachers. Students must be reminded that falsifying attendance notes is unacceptable. It is the student's responsibility to make up any work that is missed, regardless of the reason for the absence. Exceptions to this may be granted due to unforeseen circumstances. If a student becomes ill while at school, or has an appointment during school time, student's must sign out at the office. Students will only be released with parent permission. Students who are ill should not come to school and if they attend school and is deemed to be unwell, parents/guardians will be contacted to pick up their child.

If your child has important health alerts, please update the school office with written documentation.

# School Fees/School Cash Online

If you haven't already done so, please check and register for "School Cash Online" and pay for any outstanding or new school fees or items. This is the preferred method for paying for all items for school including: yearbooks, school fees, workbook fees, etc. This method is also a quicker way to receive a refund if one is required. We would like to take a moment to remind everyone that school buses drop off and pick up at that time and to ensure the safety of the students we ask you to please not park and idle in the designated bus zone. # STUDENT AND FAMILY AFFORDABILITY FUND

As you know, the Ministry of Education has provided all school districts in BC with a <u>one-time fund</u> for this school year to help support students in accessing nutritional food and clothing as well as offsetting costs for students and families. Thank you to all families that were able to give us input and feedback through the survey we sent out last month. Thank you as well to our student council and finance committee for your input. We have taken all the feedback and made the following plan in consultation with your PAC Executive:

- As part of the universal nutritional support for students and families, we are going to send home a \$50 Save-on-Foods gift card with every student. If a family decides that they would like to pass the gift card onto another student and family, there will be a process to do so. Before we send home the gift cards, we will send a message to families to let you know what day they will be distributed.
- We have also set aside some targeted funds to further support students and families. If your child and family could benefit from additional support with accessing food, clothing and/or offsetting school fee costs, please complete <u>THIS FORM</u>. Please know that all requests for support will be treated as private information and will only be shared with staff who need to know.

# **PARENT ADVISORY COUNCIL (PAC)**


