Key Points to Remember during Seismic Upgrade

Seymour address: 1130 Keefer Street V6A 1Z3 Our phone number and safe arrival line number remain unchanged. School hours are 8:45 to 2:45. Our lunch hour remains unchanged but recess will be 15 minutes earlier.

The Maquinna office will be located in the main office at Seymour (newer building) to your right as you walk into the office. Divisions 1 and 2 will be on the third floor of the newer building. Divisions 3-10 will be in the older (yellow) frame building.

Students will be expected to arrive at Maquinna by 8:10 am. The pickup area will be on Penticton Street. Buses will start loading at 8:15 and depart promptly at 8:25. Buses are not legally allowed to open their doors for late arrivals once the doors are closed.

There will be **no VSB supervision on site at Maquinna**, nor will students be transported to Seymour except on buses. Parents are responsible for getting their students to the Seymour site if late.

Attendence will be taken twice; first as students get off buses and then again by their classroom teachers.

At the end of the day, attendance will be taken again as students board buses. Students will board buses on Vernon Drive and be transported to Maquinna for 3:15 pm. If students are not picked up by a parent or do not have parent permission to walk home, they will be asked by the bus driver to reboard the bus. They will be transported to Seymour and **parents will need to come there** to pick them up.
