Dear Parents/Guardians of Grade 12 students;

Graduation Ceremony

The graduation ceremony will take place on **Tuesday, June 10 at 5:30pm** at the Italian Cultural Centre. Grad fees for the year are \$60 and can be paid online or by cash/cheque in the office and this includes the grad gown, venue, photographer, presenters and décor. Each student gets 2 complimentary tickets for guests and additional tickets (maximum 5) will cost \$10 each and can also be purchased online or by cash/cheque in the office by June 2.

Britannia School Sanctioned Dinner and Dance

The Britannia Dinner and Dance will be held on **Friday, June 13 at 6pm** at the Stanley Park Pavilion. Tickets will cost \$60 and can be paid online or by cash/cheque in the office (this fee is separate from the Grad fees). Tickets can be purchased from **April 7 – May 12**. School staff and hired security personnel jointly supervise this event. Only members of the Britannia Grad Class of 2025 can attend. The doors will open at 6pm with dinner served at 7pm and dancing, games and other activities taking place from 8pm – 11pm. A bus will pick up the students at Britannia Secondary and take them to the event as parking is limited.
