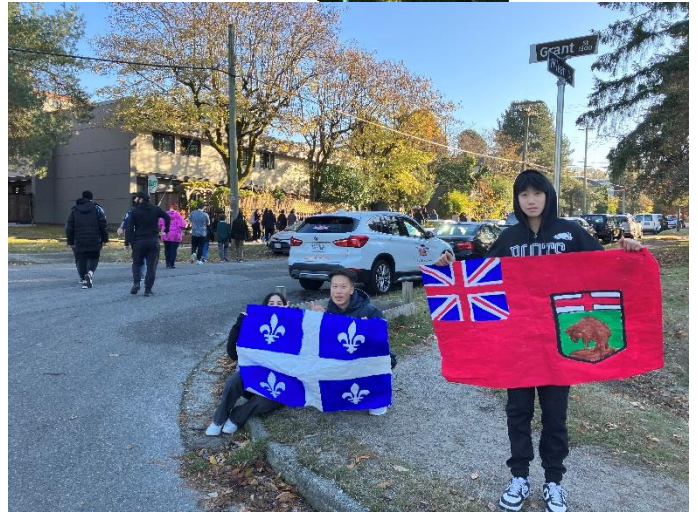
Senior Girls Volleyball
