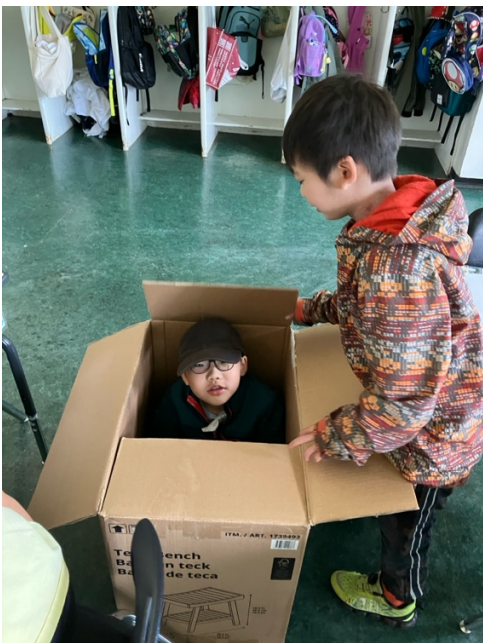

Play Day

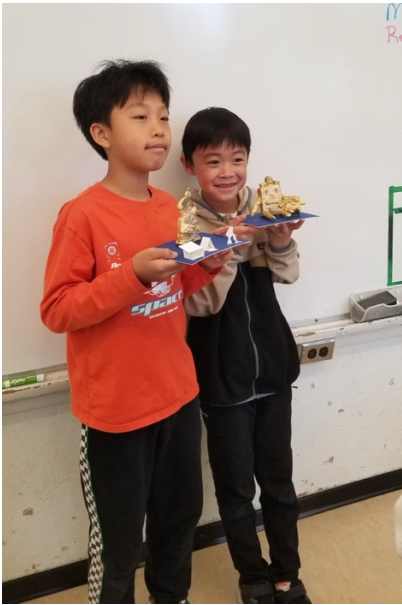

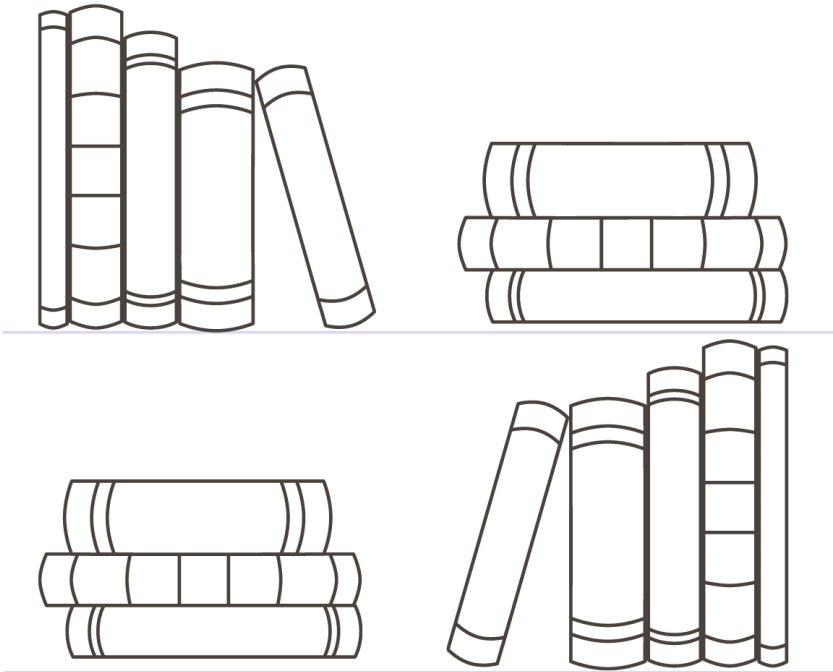
