Dear Principal / Head of School,

Annual Kindergarten hearing screening will take place at all schools in Vancouver Coastal Health during the 2024/25 school year.

Schools are asked to assist public health staff by providing a copy of the class list with the student's names, parent's names, child's birth date, telephone number and address and the option to self-identify their child as Indigenous. Section 79 of the School Act permits persons providing health services access to information in the student record required to carry out that service.

All information will be collected, used and/or disclosed in accordance with the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act. Please note that starting in the 2024/25 school year, student names who fail hearing screening will be shared with the principal. This is to let the school know that there will be follow-up screening or assessment from our audiology program.

Your school will be contacted to schedule the hearing screening visit. Once a date has been established, we will email your school a digital letter/notice for the teacher and for the parents. We request that you disseminate the parent notices 2 weeks prior to the screening. If the notices are not distributed to parents 2 weeks in advance of the screening visit, then the visit must be rescheduled.

Following screening, parents of children requiring follow up will receive a brochure advising of next steps. We value your continued support of our efforts to improve the health status of children.
