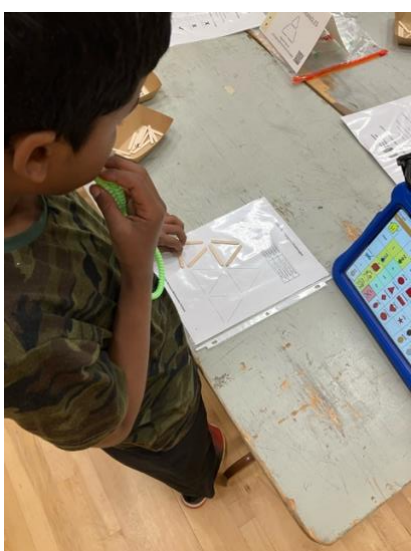
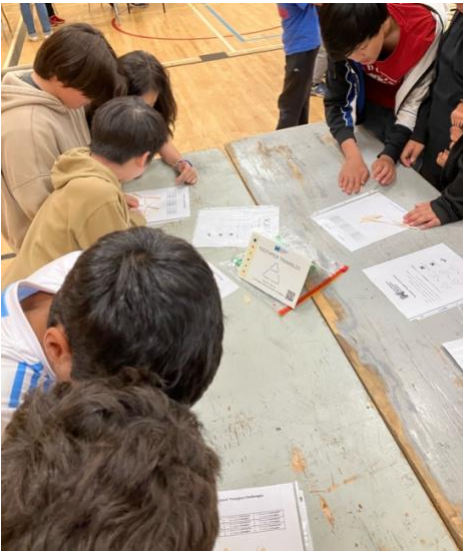
Grade 7 Leaving Ceremony
