Reporting out to parents and caregivers

Vancouver has moved to a 3 reporting periods starting this year. The reports, now called Learning Updates, will be going home on the following dates: Friday December 1, Tuesday March 12 and Monday June 24^{th.} Learning updates will look different than the past report cards. While the focus continues to be on student strengths the emphasis will shift towards process or skills. Descriptive written feedback will focus on student learning rather than reporting only on what was taught. You may see curricular competency comments that reflect a number of content areas so these content areas may be embedded into written comments. You will also notice that the proficiency scale contains 4 aspects and is not a sliding scale. While assessments such as traditional tests and quizzes provide understanding of student achievement many other assessments tools are practiced such as reflections, observations, rubrics for examples. Percentages may be included in determining student achievement but will not

Emerging means your child is beginning to understand something in an area of learning. They are still learning but may need more support to move ahead. Emerging doesn't mean your child is unsuccessful in this area.	Developing means your child understands some things in an area of learning but still has other areas to work on. Like Emerging, it doesn't mean your child is unsuccessful in this area.	Proficient is the goal for your child. It's also the goal for all students. When your child is Proficient, it means they fully understand the required learning. But it doesn't mean their learning stops.	Extending is when students show a deeper understanding. School Immunization Clinic Parent Broadcast Messaging

Dear parents/guardians, the next Osler Elementary School immunization clinic will be on November 20, 2023.

If your child is required to receive an immunization, you would have received a paper notice with clinic and specific immunization information. This notice was sent home with your child. Note, some immunizations are given over multiple doses over a longer period of time, to stimulate an effective immune response and protect against disease. Previous consent is valid for 2 years in order to complete an immunization series.

Contact us (not the school) prior to the day of clinic if:

1. Your child has received any immunizations at your family doctor's office, pharmacy, or a travel clinic.

2. You have received a notice and you no longer consent to your child to receiving immunizations at school this year.

3. You have questions
