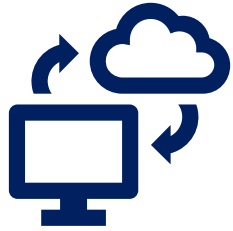

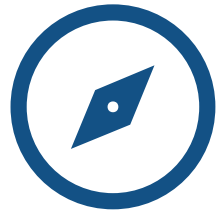

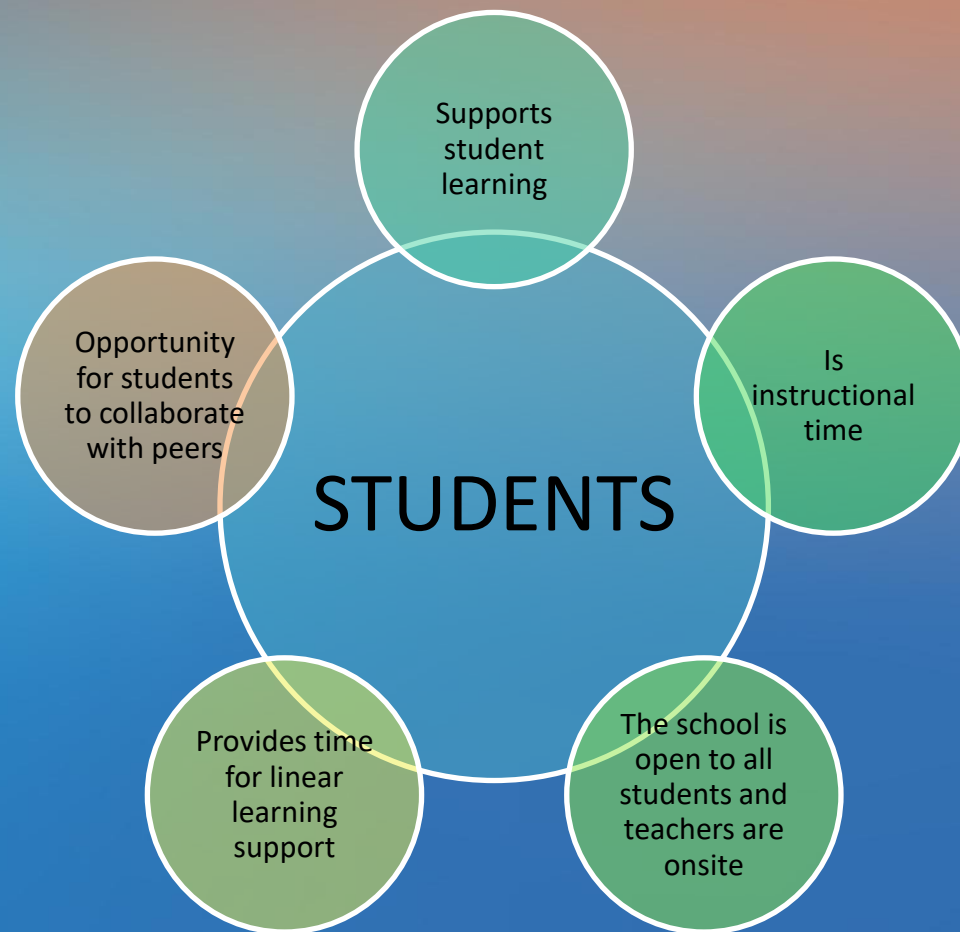

All District Learning Programs and Alternate Programs require an application that is reviewed centrally by district staff. If you are interested in pursuing one of these programs, speak with your school's resource teacher or counsellor.

FIT – FLEXIBLE INSTRUCTIONAL TIME

- 160 minutes of FIT per week
- 4 days x 40 minute periods
 - Monday & Friday morning
 - Tuesday & Thursday afternoon



Learning Hub

- Students can receive a variety of learning supports ranging from being enrolled full-time into the Learning Hub competency-based curriculum to a “drop-in-as-needed” basis to receive
- The Learning Hub team of teachers are available to students at any time during the day which allows for targeted and individualized support to each student’s specific learning needs.
