Homerooms

On **Wednesday September 3**, students will be in school for the entire day and will start the day with a homeroom from 8:40 AM – 9:00 AM and then we will follow an adjusted bell schedule. **Homeroom numbers will be available on MyEdBC and will also be posted in the foyer.**

During homerooms, teachers will go through information to start the school year. Locker selection will also occur during this homeroom. We encourage Gr. 9-12 students to bring their previously assigned school lock with them if they still have one, if students handed their lock in at the end of June a lock will be given to them in a following homeroom. Students who are new to the school or have lost their lock can purchase a new one from the office.

Students will also report to homeroom on Thursday September 4 and Friday September 5 to collect forms, review the Templeton Code of Conduct, review FIT expectations, and work through other school opening procedures.

MYEDUCATION FAMILY PORTAL

<u>MyEducationBC</u> has been closed over the summer to allow us to set up the new year and build student schedules. Access for students and families was originally scheduled to be available on August 22, however we are dealing with some changes to our course schedule that are preventing us from opening MyEd until later this week. We will be communicating to students and families to let them know when MyEducation will be available to view student schedules.

COURSE CHANGES

Our priority is to ensure students have complete timetables by having at least eight blocks scheduled. If students are missing classes or did not complete summer school as planned, we ask that you contact your grade-based counsellor. Students wanting course *changes* should email their counsellor their request, please **do not** come to the counselling suite during class time. The last day for timetable changes will be Friday September 19, 2025. After the 19th (in the exceptional circumstance where a student needs to make a course change) a course change form will need to be filled in and signed by parent/guardian, teacher(s), and administration.

SCHOOL FEES

To pay school or course fee, create an account using <u>School Cash Online</u>. The school fee schedule (an itemized list of fees to be paid by grade), can be found <u>HERE</u>. Please pay by Sept 26, 2025. Any future fees, for events such as field trips, will be available on School Cash Online. When <u>setting up</u> <u>your account</u> be sure to check "YES" to receive email notifications so that you will be notified when fees are added.
