Principal's Message

Welcome to the 2023-2024 School Year!

Dear Respected Parents, Guardians and Students,

On behalf of the Templeton staff, I welcome you to the 2023-2024 school year. I hope you had an opportunity to disconnect and recharge over the summer. I would like to extend a special welcome to our incoming Grade 8s and their families.

We enter the 2023-2024 school year with a heavy heart at the loss of a Templeton student, Erik Pettersen in early July. Erik was a compassionate and promising young man, who left a mark on those who had the privilege of knowing him. His loss is deeply felt by all of us, and our thoughts and condolences go out to Erik's family and friends during this difficult time. We also extend our deepest condolences and offer our support to all who are affected by this profound loss.

We understand that the emotional impact of losing Erik this summer has been profound for our community. As we return to school, we want all our students to feel fully supported. Our dedicated counselling team is here to provide support to students who may be experiencing grief, sadness, or other emotions during this difficult time. Additional counsellors from the District Critical Incident Team and the Child and Adolescent Response Team (CART) will also be on site and will continue to be available as needed. We have also arranged for Mr. Joe Ritchie to return to Templeton for the first week to be a support and to serve as a bridge to the new Grade 11 Counsellor Mr. Kristofer Scott. Together, we can support one another through this time.





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Students in grades 9 to 12 will attend homeroom on Tuesday September 5th for approximately one hour with grade wide assemblies being held the following week. Our grade 8 students will attend a welcome to Templeton assembly before proceeding to homeroom with the help of our outstanding group of Leo's. Homeroom lists will be posted in the main foyer and will be projected on screen for our grade 8s. The schedule is listed below:

The first full day of classes will commence on Wednesday September 6th. Cafeteria service will begin on Wednesday September 6th and library operations will begin on Monday September 11th. School photos will be taken on Monday September 11th.

Students are encouraged to pay school fees online via [School Cash Online](#). School fees can also be paid by cash in homeroom or in the main office.

Student's schedules will be available in [MyEducation BC](#) when accounts go live during the Labour Day weekend. All schedules will be printed and provided to students during homeroom on Tuesday September 5th. Counsellors will be working to make changes to students' schedule between September 5 to 15. Priority will be given to new students to Templeton, students who have incomplete timetables, and students whose courses need to change because of courses completed at summer school. If students have a full schedule and wish to request to make course changes, they must attend ALL scheduled courses, and email the grade counsellor with their name, student number, the course(s) they wish to drop, and the





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course(s) they wish to add, and counsellors will work to make the timetable changes, where possible. The last day to change schedules for semester one courses is Friday, September 15.
