Thunderbird will begin our intermediate Artist in Residence program four grade 6 and 7, with Red Buffalo Nova Weipert in the coming weeks. Nova is an Anishinaabe Ojibwe Two-Spirit and transgender interdisciplinary artist, writer, director, educator and storyteller. Nova is a proud enrolled member of the Pinaymootang First Nation located in Treaty 2 territory and is a recent graduate of the Master of Fine Arts program at Emily Carr University of Art + Design. Nova will be exploring the medium of film with our students. We are excited to welcome Nova to Thunderbird for this term.

The Vancouver School Board, District #39, and its students, staff and parent community are participating in the 2025 Ministry of Education's electronic and anonymous <u>Student Learning Survey</u> in cooperation with all other school districts throughout the Province. Parents/Guardians of grade 4 and 7 students at Thunderbird can complete this electronic anonymous survey **any time before May 2, 2025**.

This survey is intended to help the Ministry of Education and school districts plan – allowing parents and students to tell us about their education experience in their school and district. Students in Grades 4 and 7, and their parents and all staff in B.C. public schools are invited to take the annual online satisfaction survey about their school experience.

For parents to complete the survey:

- 1. Go to any computer that has up-to-date internet browser access at home, work, or school and access: <u>https://www.awinfosys.com/SurveyFull1/central/main/access.asp</u>
- Scroll down to the "<u>Parent</u>" section Direct Access. Select **39 Vancouver** from the pull-down menu next to <u>District</u>. <u>The school</u> will then appear, and you select **Thunderbird Elementary**. You can then select your desired language and click the <u>Log On</u> button.
- Complete the survey by clicking on the "radio buttons" for each question. Move to the next set of questions by clicking on <u>Arrow Button</u> in the bottom right corner of the screen. If you make a mistake, you can click the back <u>Arrow Button</u>.
- 4. When you have finished the survey, you will get a message thanking you and you are done.

Thank you for participating in this provincial project.
