I hope you all had a wonderful week. As we enter February, at Thunderbird we will be recognizing and celebrating Black History Month. Each year, Black History Month has a specific theme. This gives us a clear focus to reflect on and learn about as we think about and celebrate the contributions of Black people to society. The theme for Black History Month 2025 is **Celebrating the Mosaic: Black is Limitless.** This theme encourages us to explore the diversity of Black culture and history and serves as a reminder that Black people have been and continue to be trailblazers in many areas of life. It also serves as an invitation to examine one's own connection to Black history, culture, and identity. During this month, students will have many opportunities to learn about and celebrate the important contributions of Black Canadians to our society. We invite all in our community to learn more about Black Canadians, and how they continue to positively shape Canadian history.

Wednesday, January 29, 2025, was the Lunar New Year. It marks the first new moon of the lunisolar calendars traditional to many East Asian countries including China, South Korea, Vietnam, and more, which are regulated by the cycles of the moon and sun. 2025 is a Year of the Snake, more specifically, Wood Snake, starting from January 29th, 2025, and lasting until February 16th, 2026. Recent years of the Snake are 2013, 2001, and 1989. If you were born in one of the above years, then you are a Snake. The 12 animals of the Chinese zodiac are Rat, Ox, Tiger, Rabbit, Dragon, Snake, Horse, Goat, Monkey, Rooster, Dog, and Pig. At Thunderbird, teachers will be participating in different activities within their classroom communities.

We encourage you to read with your children as much as possible outside of the school setting to normalize reading as a fun activity to do anywhere.
