This month Ramadan is observed by many families in our community and throughout the world. Ramadan begins today, **February 28**, and will end at sundown on **Saturday, March** 29th. Ramadan is the holy month which begins with the first sighting of the crescent Moon. Ramadan is the ninth month of the Islamic calendar. It is considered a holy month that honors the time when Allah, through the angel Gabriel, revealed the first verses of the Qur'an, the holy book of Islam, to a caravan trader named Muhammad. The final evening of Ramadan culminates with a celebration called **Eid al-Fitr**, on March 29, when the month-long fast is ended with a feast.
