#### **About the Family Nature Walk**

This family-oriented biodiversity adventure is ~ 90 minutes and includes a self-guided journey through UBC Botanical Garden to find the pop-up education stations in the Garden. Activities included traversing the Greenheart TreeWalk, exploring the Forest gardens, discovering pollinators or taking time to look for slugs and watch for eagles.

Kids Nature Kits are an exciting, family-favorite element of our Family Nature Walk. When families arrive at the Garden, each child is given the first few pieces of their very own kit. As families continue their journey throughout the Garden, children collect additional fun items to help learn about the natural world and engage with science.

**WHAT:** A family ticket (max 6) provides access to the Garden to experience the Greenheart TreeWalk and to find educational stations. Children collect elements of Kids Nature Kits and there is food and light snacks for families to enjoy in the Food Garden.

WHEN: Tickets are available from 10 am - 2:30 pm on Saturday May 17.

WHERE: UBC Botanical Garden (6804 SW Marine Drive see Map)

**Step 3** - You will have to register your name and email and can apply the discount code – FNWSPEC2025 to obtain your complementary tickets.

**Step 4** – Your email order confirmation is your ticket, and we will ask the registrants name when you arrive for your scheduled time on the day-of.

Step 5 – Join us on Saturday May 17<sup>th</sup> for a wonderful time in Nature!

Lastly, on May 8, we participated in a Provincial wide earthquake drill meant to help staff and students prepare in the event of an earthquake. The drill went well, and our staff practised a limited student release to ensure our ability to reunite students with their families and an orderly and caring way in the event of an emergency. The school and its staff have a comprehensive plan and delegation of roles for adverse events to help keep students as safe and comforted as possible. In the event of a real earthquake, students would evacuate to our gravel field on the northwest corner of the school property, or to Sunrise Park on Rupert Street, if the field was unusable, where a controlled student release would occur. Please let the office know if any changes are needed to be made to the student release forms that parents or guardians filled out at the beginning of the year.
