Welcome back to the 2025–2026 school year! I hope you had a restful and enjoyable summer with your loved ones. We're excited to welcome back our returning students and families and extend a warm greeting to those joining the Thunderbird community for the first time next Tuesday.

I aim to send a weekly email on the last school day of each week—typically Friday. These messages will include important updates and information relevant to your child's experience at Thunderbird, so I encourage you to read them regularly.

## First Day of School - Grades 1 to 7

The school year begins on **Tuesday, September 2, 2025**, with a **short day from 9:00 to 10:00 am**. Returning students will go to their previous year's classrooms. New students should check in at the office and will be temporarily placed within their grade level until classes are finalized.

#### **Regular Schedule Begins**

Starting **Wednesday, September 3**, students will follow our regular schedule: **9:00 am to 3:00 pm**. Families of kindergarten students have already been contacted by their teacher—please refer to the separate schedule provided. If your child will not be returning to Thunderbird this year, please email us to let us know.

#### **Arrival and Dismissal Procedures**

Students will follow the same entry and exit routines as last year. Parents and guardians are kindly asked **not to line up with their children**. Instead, children may wait with their families in the school yard until their teacher welcomes them in their designated line. Please note that **school access for parents and guardians is by appointment only**. To ensure student safety, all non-staff adults must enter through the **main office on Cassiar Street** and sign in at reception.

## **Meal Programs**

Our hot lunch and breakfast programs resume on Thursday, September 4.

- Lunch: \$6.60/day (subsidies available). Enrollment forms and menus will be sent home during the first week.
- Breakfast: Free for all students and families, starting at 8:15 am. Please enter through the primary undercover area on the southwest side of the school.

When packing food from home, please ensure items are easy for children to open and clean up after themselves.

Please arrange for **prompt pick-up** at the end of the day. Students will be outside during recess and lunch **regardless of weather**, so please dress them appropriately and consider packing an umbrella and an extra set of clothes.

## **Class Placement**

Our team takes the class placement process seriously and invests significant time in reviewing each student's needs. Placement decisions are made collaboratively by a team of professionals—including the current teacher, Resource Teacher, School Counsellor, and Principal—based on factors such as program needs, maturity, learning styles, and academic balance.

While we do our best to accommodate preferences, it's not always possible to place every student with their preferred teacher or friends. Your support in helping your child understand this is greatly appreciated.

For **combined-grade classes**, rest assured that the Ministry of Education's curriculum for each grade will be fully delivered. Research shows that combined classes can be just as effective for student learning as single-grade classes.

If your child feels disappointed with their placement, please acknowledge their feelings and help them gain perspective. Most students adjust positively as they get to know their new teacher and classmates.

#### **Personal Digital Devices**

As of January 2024, the Province of B.C. has mandated updates to school Codes of Conduct to limit student use of personal digital devices during school hours. Devices must be **turned off or on silent and kept out of sight** from **9:00 am to 3:00 pm**, **including recess and lunch**.
