Celebrating Diwali

The Festival of Lights This year, Diwali (or Dipawali) falls on **Monday, October 20th**. Widely celebrated across India and by Indian communities around the world, Diwali is considered the most significant holiday of the year. The name comes from the Sanskrit word *avali*, meaning "row," referring to the row of clay lamps (diyas) traditionally lit outside homes to symbolize the inner light that protects from spiritual darkness. For many, Diwali holds the same cultural and spiritual importance as Christmas does for Christians—a time for reflection, celebration, and togetherness. If you have the opportunity, we encourage you to explore and enjoy one of the many vibrant Diwali festivals happening throughout the Lower Mainland this weekend.
