- ii. Nothing to report in terms of PAC outreach. Carry item over to next meeting.
- iii. Dates for spring afterschool treat stands are TBD. PAC members agreed Friday, April 25 is too soon after Easter but Friday, May 30 could work. The stand could be combined with a TCBY frozen yogurt fundraiser.
- iv. Members discussed providing the same support as last year: group caricature, out-of-school experience (potentially Rio Theatre), picnic lunch, refreshments at graduation ceremony.

- v. Community Gaming Grant application is due June 30. **Action: D. Than to prepare and submit.**

#### Fundraising Initiatives

R. Wong provided details about a TCBY frozen yogurt fundraiser. Orders can be placed online or via a form (cash). Each order comes labelled and with a spoon. Delivered in a freezer van. TCBY does most of the work but someone needs to be at the school to help distribute orders. **Action: C. Iverson to contact TCBY about a Friday, May 30 fundraiser.**
