Teacher Request

A \$500 request was made of the PAC for various library needs (baskets, supplies, printed materials, etc.). J. Iverson asked if the school could cover the cost and B. Toews said yes. The PAC DENIED the request on the premise that the school should be responsible for providing fundamental curricular materials.

FundraisingR. Wong provided an update on the Astrofoods fundraiser. Sales areInitiativesslow in general. There are approx. 20 sales to-date, with very few coming



from school families (most are friends, family and community members). R. Wong anticipates less than \$200 profits. In terms of pros, the fundraiser is easily administered. The PAC will discuss final profits and whether or not to repeat again next year in January.

Treasurer's Report D. Than provided the following report:

Other Business Bike Fest

R. Wong applied for an received a \$500 grant from the City of Vancouver. Bike Fest will proceed on Wednesday, June 4, 2025. Our Community Bikes also received a grant to provide mechanic services, so the \$500 can be used other expenditures. HUB Cycling is offering a "bike bus" weekly in the month leading up to Bike to School Week. R. Wong has submitted an expression of interest. **Action item: Add Bike Fest to January agenda to begin planning.**

Translation Services

J. Iverson asked how the school's and the PAC's communications can be more accessible, specifically for English language learners. This is an equity issue; people who cannot read English are disadvantaged. B. Toews said the VSB has translation services, but it does not have the human resources to translate day-to-day communications. J. Iverson said the solution has to be scalable and suggested an AI tool. Action item: B. Toews will speak with the District Principal of Learning and Information Technology.

Grade 6/7 Camp Fundraising

D. Than inquired about fundraising opportunities for grade 6/7 camp. B. Toews said the subsidized cost to families is \$140 and the school has the ability to pay for any student who cannot afford to attend. He suggested fundraising is better suited to graduation activities.
