Call to Order and Territorial Acknowledgement The meeting of the Thunderbird PAC (the "PAC") was called to order at

6:07 pm on May 1, 2024 by J. Iverson, Chair.

Agenda The May 1, 2024 agenda was adopted by general consent.

Meeting Minutes The April 3, 2024 meeting minutes were approved by general consent.

Business Arising from the Minutes

J. Iverson reported:

- Adjusted bottle drive totals subsequent to those on the agenda:
 478 containers = \$47.80. Total collected for graduation activities:
 \$259.20. The school exceeded its \$250 goal!
- b. A Class D gaming event licence is required for 50/50 draws. The application requires 10 days to process. Not enough time for a pub night but may consider for the Spring Carnival.
- c. The family photography session resulted in 14 bookings (6 from the school, 8 from the community). Total raised: \$220.
 Photographer will send a cheque to the PAC. R. Wong said event required a lot of organization for a relatively small return.
- d. School says Spirit Wear profits from 2023-24 are missing and those from 2022-23 are short by approximately \$50. Members requested the school investigate the missing funds. **Action: J. Iverson to email school to initiate accounting.**
